My name is Iulian Parvulescu, i'm answering to your email regarding the consultation over the draft Danube River behalf of Asociatia Speologica Exploratorii (Speleological Association Exploratorii).

We would mention from the beginning that our trust into Romanian Governmental authorities does not exist. Because stay anonymous, at least for the moment. In the future, we are willing to provide any kind of information useful for We are an Environmental NGO and our activity is usually done into South-West of Romania in Caras-Severin county

resources are limitated and this cause a peaty late reaction from our side. We want to mention here that we only recently the existence of the Draft Danube River Basin District Management Plan.

It is unusual for as treating a matter like DRBM Plan from a general point of view without mentioning environmental in the west European countries this general way of treating such a meter it will ensure positive results in the end,

leave space for interpretation serving different groups of interest and it will not lead to any kind of positive results

We consider that in Romania is necessary to point out each environmental problem with an impact over water and solutioning the problems.

There are many serious punctual problems (like the sterile from mines exploitation in Moldova Nona city) which and the groundwater, cases which we hope to be publicly discussed as sun as possible with external assistance.

We understand that this should be discussed at the Sub-Basin/national Level or the Sub-Unit Level, but we will like you know this fact.

Unfortunately, in Romania, the Administration of Hydrological Basins was never in the government agenda till this is known about more then 10 years ago. NGOs do not receive any kind of information or are not consulted about concerning the Administration of Hydrological Basins. We hope that the obligativity of Romania to participate to aspect.

Few years ago when we contacted the Romanian authorities on the meter of hydrological basin management plan

unofficial answer "there are spinning around a lot of money", so our presence - NGOs -, at the discussions table This makes us to abandon this subject. This is another reason for our lake of information about Hydrological Basins DRBM Plan.

Now we will like to present some aspects which could be relevant for DRBM Plan. General problems

- There is nothing about the carstic areas (limestone areas) where the waters have a special flow regime. Our association projects and based of the research of those projects we could sustain that many underground waters are polluted.
- We use this occasion to suggest considering the European Green Belt Initiative http://www.europeangreenbelt.org/indoor.html
 - We have accomplished a few projects over our activity area regarding water pollution. Water samples were analyzed all the surface waters are polluted at the exit points of the localities.
