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Storm surges represent a major type of natural hazard, frequently causing substantial losses of lives and economic damages.

Besides climate change drivers, storm surges are exacerbated by anthropogenic forcing including intensive land and sea use along the river-coast continuum.

How do we deal with the present level of risk?

How do we respond to changing future conditions?

Answers require interdisciplinary approaches and to overcome the traditional fragmentation in scientific and coastal user discussions and management systems. 
