 During 2001- 2006 period, grass planting area increases by 47,07%/year. Agricultural products proportion used for animal feed is 65% of the agricultural product total.

Some livestock development policies concerned to environment

- Animal breeds law: Article 19, 20 demand breeds business and production which have to ensure hygienic, animal health and environmental conditions.
- Animal health law: Article 12- Animal health hygienic conditions in livestock industry, Article 14 – Building safety zone and clean establishment for animals

- Degree No 47/2005/N§-CP, 8/4/2005, Article 20 shows that breeds business activities which are harmful to human health and environmental will be punished from 700 to 1,500 USD.
- Decision No 166/2001/Q§-TTg, 26/10/2001 by the Government prime Minister on some policies and solutions for 2001- 2010 export pig production.
- Article 2 Export pig production in the favorable condition regions for environmental and hygienic safe.

- Article 10 Ministry of Science, Technology and Environmental issued demands for export pig production establishments and organizations.
- Decision No 88/2005/Q§-BNN, 27/12/2005 of MARD on promulgating the list for valuable animal gene needed to be protection.
- Decision No 396/Q§-TTg, 20/4/2004 on subsidizing avian influenza prevention and livestock recovering cost after epidemics. Articles 2, 4 – Ensuring the budget for vaccination, cleaning activities and environmental

- Decision 574/Q§-TTg, 24/6/2005 and Decision 309/2005/Q§-TTg, 26/11/2005 by the Prime Minister on subsidizing policies for aviation influenza prevention and treatment.
- Decision 1318/Q§-TTg, 13/12/2005 on subsidizing for animal processing and concentrating slaughter establishments.
 Article 2 – only clean animals (safety animals) are permitted to be slaughtered for human foods,...

- Decision 62/200/Q§-BNN, 11/7/2002 issued demanded conditions for safety zones and establishments reserved to livestock production.
- Decision 3065/Q§-BNN, 7/11/2005 demands standard conditions for poultry breeds, eggs and products business and production
- Circulation No 69/2005/TT-BNN, 7/11/2005 on Guideline of some urgent solutions for preventing poultry H5N1

Circulations 42/2006/TT-BNN on encouraging investment, enlargement of slaughter and processing places and concentrating industrial establishments.

II. Direction for Vietnam 2010-2020 livestock development

- Increase of scale and proportion for industrial livestock production from 36,8% by 2006 to 46,9% by 2010 and 56,0% by 2020.
- 2. Proportion of animals killed by industrial methods from 4,0% by 2006 to12,4% by 2010 and 35% by 2020.

- Building epidemic control capacity. Covering and controlling foot and mouth diseases, diarrhea and flu.
- Reduce environmental pollution caused by livestock. Increasing households who have animal waste treatment system with the amount of 12% by 2006 to 45% by 2010 and 80% by 2020.
- Increasing proportion of using industrial feeds from 41,6% by 2006 to 55,5% by 2010 and 70,1% by 2020.
- Making trade mark and standardization of animal products

- Subsidy of risk and insurance for livestock production
- Encouraging sustainable livestock development closed together environmental protection
- Encouraging livestock cooperatives, club, villages, ...
- Subsidizing income, instruments for common livestock workers.
