
# Background

- ECSHD project started in 2006 (joint initiative of ABD, MRC and WWF)
- Scoping study prepared and technical document published
- Three phases planned for ECSHD project:

**Project identification** (completed July 07)

**Project formulation** (June – Sept 08)

**Project implementation** (Stage 1 Oct 08 – Mar 09; Stage 2 April 09 - Sept 10)

 Proposed project is to be jointly implemented by EP and HP

(involving dialogue partners through ADB and WWF).

## **Objectives**

- Ensure that hydropower development is sustainably developed with minimal adverse social and environmental impacts.
- Hydropower should remain a viable, profitable and renewable source of energy supporting the region's economic development.





# Second draft ECSHD project proposal





### **Potential Entry Points**

- Apply or integrate ECSHD to existing SEA (PPPs) or IEE and EIA (Project) framework and processes
- Primary entry point should be at SEA (upstream planning) level;
- Need to build on existing guidelines rather than trying to develop completely new;
- Global experience in various tools and procedures was reviewed in the scoping study; and
- Scoping study proposed use of IHA sustainability guidelines as starting point (http://www.hydropower.org) – click on sustainable initiativesIHA SGP.doc









### Methodology

#### **Step 1**:

Document current impact assessment of hydropower development in the Mekong region

#### Step 2:


Modify the existing IHA Sustainability assessment guidelines to Mekong context

#### **Step 3**:

Test these modified guidelines through current or planned SEA processes

#### **Step 4**:

Report the results of the testing phase (changed and accepted for MRC use)





### Scope and phasing

# Stage1: Testing phase

- Over 6 month-period (Oct 08 Mar 09)
- Contextualize IHA sustainability guidelines to Mekong conditions
- Testing of the guidelines
- Develop engagement plan and communication strategy
- Provide report and action plan for stage 2
- National and regional consultations




# Second draft ECSHD project proposal Scope and phasing



# Stage 2: Consolidation and capacity building phase

- Over 18 month period (April 09 Sept 10)
- Update hydropower database
- Financing sustainability
- Report on the results and acceptance of guidelines
- Capacity building need assessment and capacity building/training /awareness
- Design and seek agreement of guidelines
- Synthesize report on verified sustainability guidelines and future action plan







# Second draft ECSHD project proposal

### Implementation Arrangements

- A joint project (EP and HP)
- Overall guidance of MRC, ADB and WWF Steering Committee
- MRCS is responsible for the supervision of international and national experts
- MRC will invite dialogue partners (China and Myanmar) to participate in the project
- NMCs will work with line agencies to create National Working Groups
- Four international experts and one national expert in each country will be recruited to work on the project



# Second draft ECSHD project proposal






**Budget** 

### **Estimated budget for phase 3**:

- The total fund requirement: \$763,982
- Using available funds of \$226,319 from MRC, ADB and WWF to finance Stage 1
- Remaining \$537,663 will be raised for Stage 2





# Next Steps

- Finalize the draft project proposal based on inputs from the regional consultation
- Mobilize funds for Stage 1 from ADB/WWF/MRC and recruit consultants
- Start Phase III immediately "Project Implementation"
  - Stage 1 (Oct 08 March 09)
  - Stage 2 (April 09 Sept 10)
- MRC to liaise with IHA
