"People's suffering and economic losses due to floods are prevented, minimized, or mitigated, while preserving the environmental benefits of floods"

- 2. Structural Measures and Flood Proofing
- 3. Trans-boundary Mediation on Flood Issues
- 4. Flood Emergency Management Strengthening
- 5. Land Management
