## Component 4: Flood Emergency Management Strengthening 2004-2007



## **Main objective:**

**Emergency management systems in the Riparian countries are more effectively dealing with Mekong floods.**



**The immediate objective is competence in flood preparedness and flood mitigation strengthened, consolidated and readily available with communities, emergency managers and civil authorities, as required at each management level.**



# Expected outputs:



- **Flood preparedness programs in target areas**
- **National capacities for FPP developed**
- **Awareness campaigns conducted.**
- **Regional knowledge-sharing facilitated**
- **Province-to-Province trans-boundary emergency assistance facilitated.**



# Achievements

- **Launched in September 2004**
- **Start-up meeting with NMCs in Oct. and Nov. 2004**
- **Implementation arrangement with line agencies,**
- **Selection of pilot provinces/districts and detailed work plan**
- **Initial dialogue with partners and recruitment of staff**

# Achievements under DIPECHO:

- Assessments (strength/weaknesses)
- Adaptation of training curriculum
- Conducting the pilot training courses
- Development of institutionalization plan for the training course



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## Component 5: Land Management 2004-2007

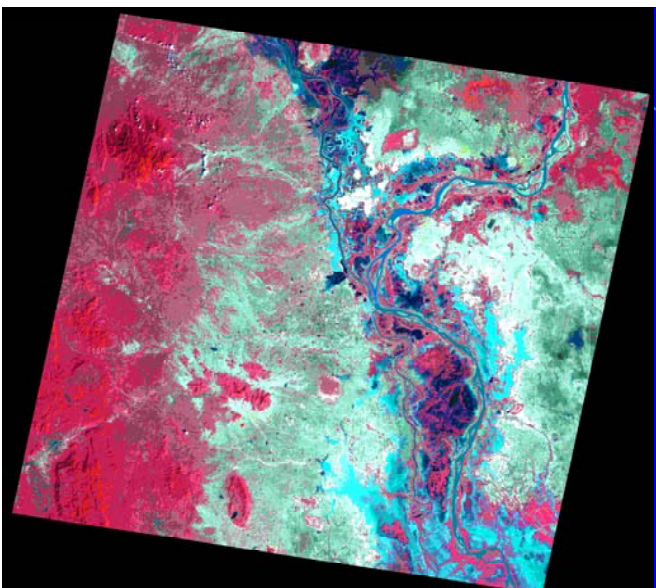

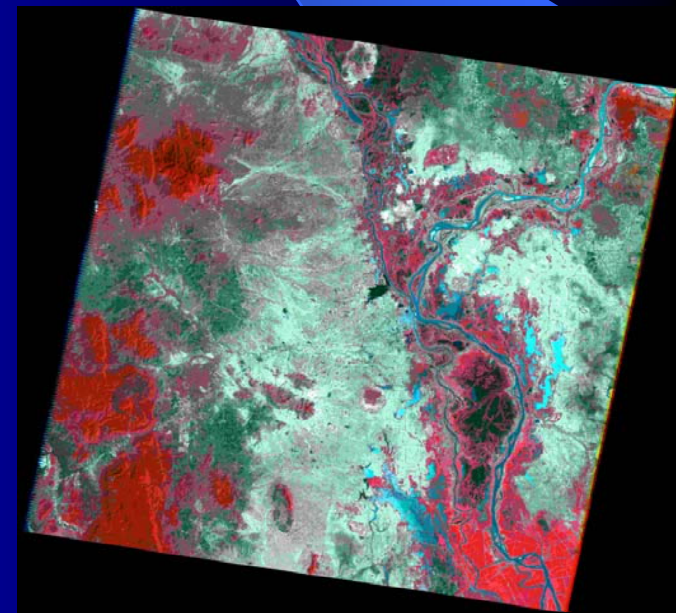

## **Main objective:**

**Land management in the Mekong flood plains is more effective, using reliable flood-related information**

**The immediate objective of this component is 'institutional, human resources and technical support being available to sustainable land management and improved land use planning integrated into floodplain management and mitigation in the LMB.'**





## **Expected outputs:**

- **More reliable flood probability information is provided for land information systems in selected provinces and districts."**
- **The capacity of relevant line agencies in selected provinces and districts to prepare and implement improved land use plans is strengthened; Regional sharing of knowledge on improved land management in floodplains is facilitated**
- **Awareness campaigns conducted.**
