Mr. Millette's previous assignment was as the Deputy Assistant Secretary for Budget and Planning in the Bureau of Resource Management. He also served as the Director of Resources for the Foreign Building Program, and for eight years he was a senior policy advisor to the Chief Financial Officer primarily responsible for representing the Department of State interests with appropriation and authorizing committees in Congress.

Mr. Millette began his career in 1980 with the Bureau of Labor Statistics. He remained there for six years. He accepted the position as Economist to the Comptroller at the Department of State and remained there for five years. In 1991 Mr. Millette left government service for the private sector. He returned to the State Department three years later.

Mr. Millette received a masters degree from the University of Massachusetts/Amherst in 1980 and a bachelors degree in Economics from Providence College in 1978.
