	Subject:	2011 Pacific Climate Change Roundtable (PCCR) 14 – 18 March 2011, Niue

Further to the circular sent out on 19th November 2010, we would like to remind you that the 2011 Pacific Climate Change Roundtable (PCCR) will be convened from 14-18 March in Niue.

The theme for the 2011 PCCR would be 'Mobilising Climate Change Resources" and the meeting will focus on the four major themes:

- 1. Climate change finance
- 2. Climate Change Policy in the Pacific
- 3. Knowledge Management on Climate Change
- 4. Climate Change negotiations

A draft agenda has been attached for your information.

While the meeting will run for four working days, participants will need to be in Niue for the full week (11th to 18th March). Please note that there is a field trip scheduled on Saturday 12th of March, and the official meetings will run from the 14th to 17th, allowing for all participants to leave on the flight out on the Friday 18th.

National Focal Points are asked to please send their nominations to Joyce Tulua email: joycet@sprep.org no later than the 17th January, so that flights and transit visas can be secured early. SPREP will be paying for the participation costs of two people from each Pacific Island Country and one person per Pacific Island territory.

Additional to these two funded participants, the Pacific Adaptation to Climate Change (PACC) Project will be covering the costs for the participation of PACC Coordinators. Additional information on logistics will be sent to the participants, once nominations are confirmed.
