In April 2002, the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) committed themselves to achieve a significant reduction of the current rate of biodiversity loss at the global, regional and national level as a contribution to poverty alleviation and to the benefit of all life on Earth by 2010. As a result the year 2010 has been designated as the International Year of Biodiversity by the United Nations.

strategy

- Identify and concentrate on 4-5 priority CBD issues for our region
- Identify regional people to follow the issues
- Decide on a focal point for these issues
- Support new Asia-Pacific COP Bureau representative Tania Temata of the Cook Islands.
- Include other organisations to assist and support COP 10 preparations e.g CROP agencies, NGOs etc.
- Undertake negotiations training and identify opportunities to highlight Pacific positions. (for example, relevant CBD related meetings that the Pacific should engage e.g AHTEGs Working Groups, Expert Groups.)
- Showcase and highlight Pacific achievements. Choose high profile topics and connect with commemorating "2010 International Year of Biodiversity".
- Liaise with Pacific Tourism Offices based in Japan.
- Have creative displays depicting Pacific achievements at COP 10.
- Approach the Government of Japan for assistance in planning Pacific interaction with COP 10.
- Continue to work closely with our Small Islands Developing states colleagues to progress our issues.
