Please Note: There are two processes to follow in this timetable:

- 1. Agreement on the contents of a Project Identification Form (PIF) requesting further funding from GEF. This MUST be accompanied by Letters of Endorsement from each participating country's GEF Operational Focal Point stating that they support this PIF proposal and that it is in line with their national commitments. This process is in red text above.
- 2. Endorsement of the Strategic Action Programme at the Ministerial level. Once a PIF has been submitted and technically approved it can be submitted to the GEF Council in June for adoption into the GEF Work Programme. However, ALL countries would have to have signed/endorsed the SAP at ministerial level by June for the GEF CEO to adopt this into the Work Programme. If this does not happen then the countries will have to wait for the next GEF funding cycle which realistically could take until end of 2014. This process is in blue text above.
