


## Concluding remarks (2)

- Ecosystem Approach is an approach to management
- .. not to science but has implications for science
- EA has two dimensions
- Horizontal cross sectoral /integrated management
- Vertical within sector / fisheries

## Concluding remarks (3)


- EA ... requires an ecosystem
- "(b) Be applied withing geographically specific areas based on ecological criteria"
- LME, LOMA, regions ...
- Larger scale (pollution, climate, highly migratory stocks, etc.)
- Smaller scale coastal zone, watersheds, etc.





### Definition – Ecosystem Approach

• "the comprehensive integrated management of human activities based on the best available scientific knowledge about the ecosystem and its dynamics, in order to identify and take action on influences which are critical to the health of marine ecosystems, thereby achieving sustainable use of ecosystem goods and services and maintenance of ecosystem integrity"

- Marine regions/subregions as management units
