Agenda Item 7.1: Report on Members' Contributions

Purpose

1. To report to the Meeting on the receipt of Members' contributions.

Background

- 2. Financial Regulation 14 requires the Director to submit to each SPREP Meeting a report on the receipt of Members' contributions. This report provides an update on the status of Members' contributions received in 2010 (up to 30 June) as well as sharing the status of Members' contributions as at the end of 2009. A verbal update on the status of Members' contributions as at September 2010 will be presented to the 2010 SPREP meeting.
- 3. The 20th SPREP Meeting 'committed itself to paying current and unpaid contributions in 2009.' The Meeting also encouraged the Director 'to raise the issue of unpaid contributions with relevant senior officials when he is visiting countries,' which he did by following up in person and by sending a number of reminders by circular and letter.

Members' Contributions received in 2009 and 2010 (to 30 June 2010)

- 4. Attached for information is a statement which shows the amounts due from respective members as at 30 June 2010. As the table indicates, a total of US\$1,143,826 was received by the Secretariat in 2009, leaving a balance of \$391,355 of unpaid contributions as at 31 December 2009.
- 5. The total contributions outstanding as at 30 June 2010 is \$763,210 made up of \$374,263 unpaid for 2009 and previous years, and \$388,947 for 2010.
- 6. Of the total of \$935,572 contributions due for 2010, as of 30 June, the Secretariat had received \$563,717, including amounts towards previous years' unpaid contributions.
