■ Key Result

1. (National Marine Litter Monitoring) The main factor that pollutes the coast

area of the Yellow sea is plastic(account for 77% of marine litter in the

coast. The second biggest factor is foreign source marine litter(7%)

competing neck and neck with glass(7%).

2. (Marine Litter Removal) 49,454 ton of Marine Litter was removed in the

Yellow Sea area.

Conclusion

In order to reduce the amount of plastic which is the major source of marine

litter, ROK has come up with a master plan to reduce plastic as well as the 3rd

national marine litter management plan. And other legislations to enhance

marine litter management infrastructures are also in the pipeline
