






1. Civilian monitoring of the marine protected area at the mouth of Geumgang River (Yubudo Island)









- ✓ 2008: Designated as protected wetland (15.3 sq. km.)
- ✓ 2009: Registered as Ramsar Wetland
- ✓ 2018: Designated protected wetland area widened (68.09 sq. km.)

- Location: wetlands of Yubudo Island

- Surveys are being undertaken by state research institutions and civic groups related to waterfowl, but the number of such surveys is inadequate due to a lack of accessibility and personnel. Due to such limitations, surveys are not being conducted systematically.
- Monitoring is being conducted alongside educational activities for local residents.












3. Ecological restoration of the mouth of Geumgang River



- √ 1990: Construction of estuary embankment for Geumgang River
- ✓ Problems: decline in water quality, decrease in biodiversity, sedimentation, chlorosis of laver, and downturn of fishing industry
- Changes in mudflat ecosystem influencing the food supply for spoon-billed sandpipers
