Breeding along the northeast coast of Russia Wintering China's yellow and bohai sea region-to southeast Asia coast (mainly mangrove wetlands)

Coastal wetland

ae Marine Ecosyster

Coastal mudflats in Yellow-bohai sea area are the most important resting place for SBS;

Zhanjiang wetland is the largest known wintering site in China;

Threats

Habitat loss due to global climate change, reclamation of coastal wetlands and invasive species ; Illegal hunting

➤To improve the conservation effectiveness and management capacity building on EAAF;

Project Introduction

Support scientific research projects and synchronous monitoring to provide data support for better understanding and protection of SBS

Capacity building through various training methods, e.g. combining indoor lectures and field practice, to improve the management and monitoring ability of relevant officials, professionals and volunteers Capacity building CEPA Research & Monitor **Project goals**

Through workshops, news bulletins, special exhibition, documentary and related outreach activities, establishing sister reserve protection activities, to promote public awareness

Established a protection case participant by the government, enterprises, universities, research institutions, Ngos; establish an international SBS protection team; make it a demonstration project on EAAF; improve project international influence and conservation significantly




